IMPORTATION OF DOGS AND CATS INTO GRENADA

The Importation of dogs and/or cats into Grenada from the United States of America is permitted provided that:

- 1. The owner of the dog and/or cat have/has an Import Permit Issued by the Veterinary Officer of the Grenada Ministry of Agriculture. The Permit must be presented at the Port of Entry.
- 2. The dog and/or cat have/has been vaccinated against rabies within twelve (12) months prior to arrival.
- 3. The dog and/or cat are/is accompanied by a health certificate issued by a Veterinarian within the two (2) weeks prior to arrival.
- 4. The Grenada Veterinary Officer is notified of the Port of Entry and the time of arrival.

In applying for the Import Permit, the owner must give the age, sex, colour and breed of his/her dog and/or cat. The applicant must:

- 1. Complete the Pet Permit with the Applicant's name and country of residence with pet.
- 2. Complete the particulars requested on yourpet(s).
- 3. Complete the Port or Airport of Landing in **GRENADA**.
- 4. Complete the expected date of arrival in Grenada.
- 5. You have completed your portion of the permit.
- 6. Permit should be faxed to the Veterinary Department at (473) 440–4191 along with Health Certificate for approval and signature, at least two (2) weeks prior to arrival in Grenada.
- 7. Please provide a return fax number to the Veterinary Department to have the signed Permit returned to you.
